Most are primarily a nuisance and cause little damage. Some, such as Pharaoh ants, may infest food. Others, like carpenter ants, can weaken wood in structures.

Many ants have developed a variety of symbiotic relationships with other invertebrates and plants, sometimes to mutual benefit, sometimes not. One of the most common is the herding or farming of sap feeding insects ' homopterans' such as aphids, scale bugs and mealy bugs.

Whether the winged ant you see is a carpenter ant or a termite, however, the wings mean that the insect is a reproductive male or queen—the only members of an ant colony that can reproduce. Ants and termites swarm to mate, then the males die, having done their duty, and the queens drop their wings to find a nesting site.

Some ant species are predatory, killing and eating other insects—including other species of ants—and even small animals. Some ants are, like vultures and hyenas, carrion-eaters: They prefer dead or decaying sources of protein. And some ants might even be called agriculturalists.
